

TEACH

To teach, baptise and nurture new believers.

Key texts: 2 Corinthians 2,7, Jeremiah 33:3

ASK Use these questions to direct conversation and reflection.

Do you often feel like you **can't teach or share your faith with others**? What factors contribute to this feeling, and how can you overcome them to fulfill the call to teach, baptise, and disciple others in your everyday life?

Reflect on instances in your life **where someone taught you valuable lessons or shared their faith journey** with you.

How did these experiences **impact your own understanding of God** and your relationship with Jesus?

Consider the **motivation behind your actions** in teaching and sharing your faith.

Are you motivated by the love of Jesus, or do you see it merely as a routine part of your life? How can you **align your motivation with the love and mission of Christ**?

Think about **Jesus' example of teaching His disciples** not only through words but also through everyday experiences and interactions.

How can you **emulate this approach** in your relationships with others to share the love of Jesus effectively?

In what ways can you **actively listen to Jesus' guidance** and **respond to His call** to teach, baptise, and disciple others in your home, family, street, or community?

How can you be **open to the promptings of the Holy Spirit** in your everyday life?

MAIN THEMES:

Through prayer, generous giving, embracing change, and discovering our unique roles, we can actively participate in tending to the lives of those who are suffering and in need.

ACT Use these action points to direct action and initiative.

Be Intentional: Seek opportunities to teach and disciple others, even in seemingly small ways. Whether it's mentoring a colleague, sharing your faith with a friend, or helping someone understand a biblical concept, embrace these moments with love and patience.

Invest Time: Study the Scriptures and deepen your understanding of Jesus' teachings and mission. Let your knowledge of God's Word inform and guide your conversations and interactions with others.

Meet With Others: Organise or participate in a small group or study circle where you can explore and deepen your understanding of faith together. Create a safe space for questions, doubts, and mutual learning and growth.

Challenge Self-Limiting Beliefs: Challenge the idea that you can't make a difference or impact others' lives positively. Embrace the truth that you can do all things through Christ who gives you strength (Philippians 4:13). Trust in the power of the Holy Spirit working through you.

Pray for God's Guidance: Ask Him to inspire you through His Holy Spirit, revealing the unique ways in which He has gifted you to teach and share your faith.

Remember: Each interaction, big or small, presents an opportunity to teach and demonstrate God's love. Be intentional about showing kindness, compassion, and grace to those around you.

Tell Your Story: Your story is unique. Use your own testimony to teach, inspire and support others on their spiritual walk.
